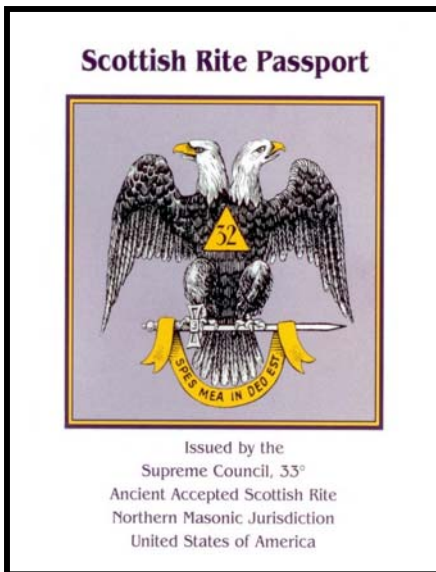

ARE YOU MOVING OR HAVE YOU RECENTLY MOVED?

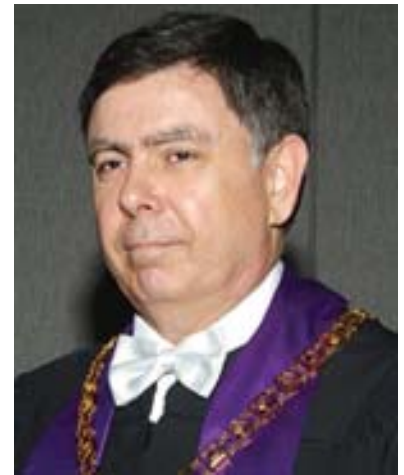
