



2008 Golf Outing Fundraiser to Benefit the 32° Masonic Learning Center

On Friday, September 12, 2008 the Valley of Akron will hold its 2nd Annual Charity Golf Outing at Brookledge Golf Course in Cuyahoga Falls, Ohio. Our event is open to the public, all Masons, their friends and all golfing enthusiasts, male or female, who would enjoy a great day of golf, food, fellowship and fun. This year's Golf Outing plans to be better than ever, with better prizes and an excellent silent auction after play. The cost for this outing is \$65.00 for senior golfers, 62 years of age and over, and \$75.00 for golfers under age 62. The format will again be a shotgun start at 9:00 a.m. Late registration, cart and tee assignments, continental breakfast, and free practice range balls will get under way at 7:45 a.m.

Our main fundraising comes from the sale of hole sponsorships and items or services donated for the silent auction. This year, all hole sponsorships and donations are 501(c)(3) tax deductible. All profits from this outing will go towards the operating expenses for the Valley of Akron's Learning Center. \$500.00 (includes entry fees for 2 players) or silver level at \$100.00 per hole.
