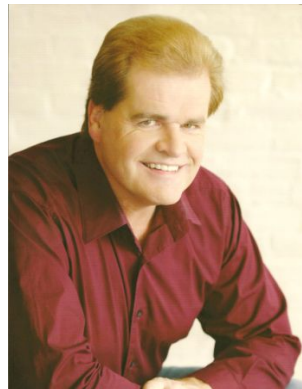
2008 WALK OCTOBER 4TH

We would like to once again invite you, your family and friends to take part in our fundraising WALK TO HELP CHILDREN WITH DYSLEXIA. The Walk will be held October 4th at the Wadsworth Shelter Area on Sand Run Parkway with walkers departing at 9:00 am.
